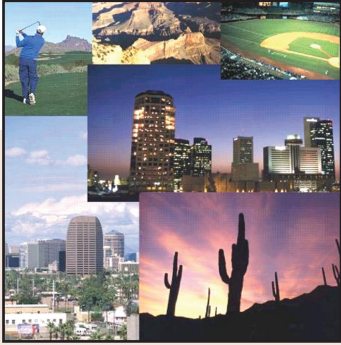


Family Auxiliary Program and Tour
