-Hardee CI is a two unit facility housing close, medium, minimum and community custody inmates. The Main Unit houses 1675 inmates and functions as close custody facility. There are 53 beds dedicated to administrative confinement and 100 beds dedicated to disciplinary confinement. The remaining beds are general population. One dormitory is dedicated to the Florida Department Corrections Re-Entry Mission. Inmates assigned to this dormitory are within sixty months of release and would never be eligible for participation in community work release programs. Re-Entry inmates are evaluated upon assignment and a personal program including education/academics and self improvement classes are provided. All Re-entry programming is provided with minimal funding and engages volunteers as well as trained inmate teaching assistants. Hardee Work Camp houses 288 inmates and provides 12 Department of Corrections Work Squads to the surrounding communities. Inmates assigned to the Work Camp also participate in Re-Entry programs with the primary focus being on adult literacy and GED testing.
