

Solicitation of Candidates For the 2010 ACA Election



The ACA Nominating Committee requests that all affiliates, chapters and individual members submit suggested candidates for officers, members of the Board of Governors and Delegate Assembly, and seats on the Commission on Accreditation for Corrections. It is impossible for the committee to know the interests and abilities of all ACA members; therefore, your help is essential. Positions to be filled are as follows (Each category will have a double slate of candidates, Article II, Sections 1 and 2):

OFFICERS: one President-Elect, one Vice President and one Treasurer

BOARD OF GOVERNORS: Made up of 19 elected members. Pursuant to Article III, Section 4 of the ACA bylaws, the term of each elected governor shall be four years, and no governor shall serve more than two consecutive terms or eight consecutive years. At each biennial election, either nine or 10 governors shall be elected to terms of four years each. The following positions are open:

- ◆ Aftercare or Post-Release Supervision (Juvenile)
- ◆ At Large Ethnic Minority (2)
- ◆ Community Programs (Juvenile)
- ◆ Correctional Administration (Juvenile)
- ◆ Education
- ◆ Health Care
- ◆ Member At-Large
- ◆ Parole or Post-Release Supervision (Adult)
- ◆ Probation (Juvenile)

COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION: Pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the ACA bylaws, commissioners shall be elected to terms of four years each. The following positions are open:

- ◆ At-Large Correctional Health (4)
- ◆ At-Large Member (2)
- ◆ Probation and Parole (Adult)
- ◆ Probation/Aftercare (Juvenile)

DELEGATE ASSEMBLY: Comprised of 42 elected at-large members from the following disciplines of the correctional continuum. Pursuant to Article IV, Section 3 of the ACA bylaws, the term of office of an at-large Delegate Assembly member shall be two years, and no at-large Delegate Assembly member shall serve more than eight consecutive years. The following positions are open:

- ◆ Correctional Education Services (Adult) (2)
- ◆ Correctional Education Services (Juvenile) (2)
- ◆ Detention (Adult) (2)
- ◆ Detention (Juvenile) (2)
- ◆ Institutions (Adult) (2)
- ◆ Institutions (Juvenile) (2)
- ◆ Institutional Line Operating Personnel (Adult) (2)
- ◆ Institutional Line Operating Personnel (Juvenile) (2)
- ◆ Institutions of Higher Learning (4)
- ◆ Private Community-Based Correctional Organizations (4)
